

2010 CHURCH CAMP COUNSELOR APPLICATION

**Thank you for considering being a church camp counselor this summer!
Elementary/Junior High Camp is June 13-16, and High School Camp is June 16-19.
Please take a moment to read and fill out this application.**

Eligibility:

You must have completed your freshman year of high school in order to be an Elementary Camp Counselor (grades 3 to 5), and you must have completed your junior year of high school in order to be a Junior High Camp Counselor (grades 6 to 8) (please note that elementary and junior high camp are held together). If you are applying to be a High School Camp counselor, you must have completed at least two years of college or the equivalent. Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to following Christ in their own lives, and a willingness to share their faith with others.

Expectations:

Time Commitment—**ALL Counselors** will be expected to attend one pre-camp meeting...time and location TBD.

Elementary and Junior High Camp Counselors will be expected to arrive at camp at 3:00pm on Sunday, June 13th and stay at camp until Wednesday afternoon, June 16th. All High School Camp Counselors will arrive at camp at 3:00pm on Wednesday afternoon, June 16th, and stay at camp until Saturday afternoon, June 19th.

ALL counselors are expected to attend Sunday morning's camp worship service on June 20st where we will give testimonies of the week, show a slideshow of pictures, sing camp songs, and actively lead in worship.

Work Commitment—While being a camp counselor is a LOT of fun, you will have some responsibilities while at camp. Some of the different tasks may include: leading a small group, offering a devotion (morning watch or vespers), helping with crafts, games, snacks, skits, music, etc. All counselors will be responsible for keeping track of a cabin of youth. It will be your job to make sure these youth are where they should be at all times, that they are staying safe, growing in Christ, and having fun!

Financial Commitment—Because of increasing camp costs, we must ask all counselors to contribute \$75 to cover some of our expenses.
